The Party of European Socialists as a 'second force' of the European Parliament;</li> <li>7. European liberals - the 'tongue of the balance' in the European Parliament;</li> <li>8. The European Green Party and Party of European Left in the European Union party system;</li> <li>9. Alliance of European Conservatives and Reformists and European Conservatives and Reformists Group in EP – the most 'Polish' transnational structure of parties in the EU political space;</li> <li>10.
