Functions of Europarties (function of electoral - European Parliament elections, interest articulation function, function of participation in EU decision-making, function of integration); 5. The European People's Party (and EPP Group in the European Parliament) – the strongest transnational party in the European Union; 6. The Party of European Socialists as a 'second force' of the European Parliament; 7. European liberals - the 'tongue of the balance' in the European Parliament; 8. The European Green Party and Party of European Left in the European Union party system; 9. Alliance of European Conservatives and Reformists and European Conservatives and Reformists Group in EP – the most 'Polish' transnational structure of parties in the EU political space; 10. Eurosceptic transnational federations of parties; 11. Transnational parties aspiring to the status of political party at European level (Europarty) and others transnational party federations in the EU; 12. The Polish representatives in the political groups of the European Parliament.
